At point no 4 of the said Memorandum, it is decided that the amount of Performance Security deposited under all existing Contracts shall be reduced from existing 5-10% to 3 % of the Contract value. A copy of the said office Memo dated 12.11.2020 issued by the Ministry of Finance is enclosed as **Annexure-1** hereto for your ready reference.

In furtherance whereof, the Secretary (Expenditure), has also addressed a communication to the Chief Secretaries of all State Government's, requesting them to consider issuing directions similar to those issued in the Office Memo by the Ministry of Finance dated 12.11.2020 as aforesaid. A photocopy of such communication is also attached herewith as **Annexure-2**.

In considerations thereto, the Governments of various States such as Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, West Bengal et-al., have issued instructions for adopting similar measures to provide relief to the contractors engaged in the execution of works in their respective States, pursuant to the directions issued in the said Office Memorandum from the Ministry of Finance. Copies of such Govt. orders/Memorandums issued by **Governments of Andhra Pradesh**, **Telangana** and **West Bengal** are collectively enclosed as **Annexure-3** hereto.

In light of the prevailing situation, we humbly request you to lend a considerate view to our request and provide directions for implementing the relief measures by way of effecting a reduction in the percentage of

Performance Security to 3% of Contract Value in line with the directions contained in the Office Memo by the Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India.

Such timely support shall not only facilitate the contractors to mitigate the immediate challenges effectively and ensure the completion of ongoing works smoothly but shall also provide necessary encouragement during these trying times for taking up complex projects which are intended to bring welfare and benefit to the people of the state.
